

Requirements for Enrollment to Rockdale Recovery High School

Rockdale Recovery High School is a learning environment. All students must demonstrate commitment to both their education and their recovery.

- 1) In order to enroll in Rockdale Recovery High School, all prospective students must be clean and sober prior to their school start date and must be able to show evidence of their sobriety in the form of monitored drug test results.
- 2) Students are required to be in recovery while attending Rockdale Recovery High School.
- 3) All enrolled students must work with the Recovery Clinician to develop an individualized Recovery Plan. In the event of relapse, the Recovery Plan may be revised to provide increased support for the student.
- 4) Students must participate fully in substance abuse recovery programming offered at RRHS.
- 5) Students must attend a minimum of 2 self-help (e.g. AA, NA) meetings (or equivalent outside activities) each week.
- 6) In order to attend Rockdale Recovery High School, students must be in average good health. RRHS is handicap-accessible. RRHS is further committed to making reasonable accommodations for anyone with a disability. Personal care attendants are required to follow all of the policies of Rockdale Recovery High School.
- 7) Prospective students are expected to answer all questions honestly during the interview process. This will enable RRHS staff to work most effectively with applicants while they await enrollment decisions and if/when they are admitted to Rockdale Recovery High School. Dishonesty is cause for disenrollment at RRHS.
